

## ADVERB OF MANNER

### Apa Itu Adverb of Manner?

Hello homies! Kali ini kita akan membahas tentang adverb of manner. Sebelum kita membahas tentang adverb of manner, udah pada tau apa yang dimaksud dengan adverb belum? Jadi adverb itu adalah kata keterangan ya homies. Lalu apakah itu adverb of manner? Adverb of manner adalah kata keterangan yang digunakan untuk menyatakan bagaimana cara sebuah kegiatan dilakukan. Sebagai contoh ‘*saya bisa berbahasa inggris dengan lancar*’ maka dalam bahasa inggris menjadi ‘*I can speak English fluently*’. “fluently” adalah salah satu contoh dari adverb of manner.

### Pembentukan Adverb of Manner

Setelah mengetahui pengertiannya mari kita lihat bagaimana pembentukan dari adverb of manner ya homies. So, adverb of manner di bentuk dari *adjective* (kata sifat) yang ditambahkan akhiran *-ly*.

Aturan pembentukan	Adjective	Adverb of manner
Hanya ditambahkan <i>-ly</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- cheap</li><li>- quick</li><li>- strong</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- cheaply</li><li>- quickly</li><li>- strongly</li></ul>
Adjective berakhiran <i>-y</i> didahului oleh huruf konsonan, maka <i>-y</i> diganti menjadi <i>I</i> sebelum akhiran <i>-ly</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- happy</li><li>- easy</li><li>- busy</li><li>- hungry</li><li>- lazy</li></ul> <p>Pengecualian:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- shy</li><li>- sly</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- happily</li><li>- easily</li><li>- busily</li><li>- hungrily</li></ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- shyly</li><li>- slyly</li></ul>
Adjective berakhiran <i>-y</i> didahului oleh huruf vokal, hanya ditambahkan akhiran <i>-ly</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- coy</li><li>- grey</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- coyly</li><li>- greyly</li></ul>
Frequency adverbs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Frequent</li><li>- general</li><li>- rare</li><li>- usual</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- frequently</li><li>- generally</li><li>- rarely</li><li>- usually</li></ul>
Connecting adverbs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- consequent</li><li>- subsequent</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- consequently</li><li>- subsequently</li></ul>
Adjective dan adverb punya pola yang sama	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- fast</li><li>- hard</li><li>- little</li><li>- loud</li><li>- much</li><li>- straight</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- fast</li><li>- hard</li><li>- little</li><li>- loud (informal)</li><li>- much</li><li>- straight</li></ul>
Irregular adverb	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- good</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- well</li></ul>
Jika adjective berakhiran	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- understandable</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- understandably</li></ul>

-le, ganti -e di akhir menjadi -y	- forcible - possible	- forcibly - possibly
Jika adjective berakhiran -ic, tambahkan -ally di akhir menjadi -y	- idiotic - tragic - basic  Pengecualian: - public	- idiotically - tragically - basically  - publicly

### Rumus Adverb of Manner

1. Setelah main verb jika tidak ada direct object.

Example:

He walks slowly (dia bejalan dengan lambat)

2. Setelah main verb + object (transitive verb).

Example:

Andi can speak English fluently (Andi bisa berbicara bahasa inggris dengan lancar)

3. Diantara auxiliary verb dan main verb.

Example: Things will slowly come together (segalanya akan secara perlahan membaik)

### Contoh Kalimat Adverb of Manner

- he ran **quickly**.
- The English teacher spoke **slowly**.
- The audience laugh loudly.
- Please speak **quietly** when you are in the library.
- Kelly drives **carefully**.
- The boy asked **politely** for more candy.
- Please move **calmly** towards the exit.
- The student sat there **silently** waiting for the class to start.
- The student answered all question **correctly**.
- Please drive home **safely**.
- I asked him **repeatedly**, but he didn't answer.
- Chris **successfully** completed the London marathon.
- My flight was delayed **unexpectedly** delayed.
- Everything went **smoothly** at the interview today.
